

Estimated Cost of Attendance

To help you better understand the costs associated with your education, the WW Graduate School's estimated student budget is outlined below. This budget is based on a single student and assumes a moderate student lifestyle. It includes one-time costs and estimated monthly expenses.

Please keep in mind that the estimated budget does not reflect need-based Graduate School scholarships/grants that you might be eligible for. Our financial aid program is designed to provide access and affordability to all students. Please see the tuition and financial aid portion of the website for more information.

Health insurance is required for all students by the commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Graduate School will offer a health plan for those who seek coverage; its estimated cost is still pending.

*The Graduate School does not provide housing or meal plans. These are estimates based on the area to help you budget.

**The transportation costs represent an unlimited monthly CharlieCard for both the subway and bus systems that stretches all of Boston/Cambridge. We expect most students will use the T as The Graduate School is just two blocks away from the Lechmere stop. If you are driving into the city you would need to factor in local parking.
